Adult category

Men -70kg/-80kg/-90kg/ + 90kg

Women -55kg/ -65kg/ +65kg

Adult category competitors allocations per category:

- 2 fighters for IFK organisation per country
- 2 fighters for non IFK organisations per country

If the IFK country does not fill its allocation, then these spaces can be filled by the non IFK organisations.

A maximum of 4 fighters from a country in a category

Adult category host nation competitors allocations per category:

- 4 fighters for IFK organisation per country
- 4 fighters for non IFK organisations per country

If the IFK country does not fill its allocation, then these spaces can be filled by the non IFK organisations.

A maximum of 8 fighters from a country in a category

Adult category bout duration:

2 minute, 2 minute, weight, 2 minutes enchosen (if 5kg weight difference the lighter competitor is declared the winner. 8kg in Men's Heavyweight)

Final 3 minute, 2 minute, 2 minute. (no weight decision).

Adult category compulsory safety equipment:

Shin and instep for women only/ men groin guard/ women breast protector (cup type).

Under 21 category (the competitor must be 18 years to 20 years old on the first day of the competition) (6 categories)

Men -70kg/-80kg/+80kg

Women -55kg/ -65kg/ +65kg

Under 21 category competitors allocations per category:

- 2 fighters for IFK organisation per country
- 1 fighter for a non IFK organisations per country

If the IFK country does not fill its allocation, then these spaces can be filled by the non IFK organisations.

A maximum of 3 fighters from a country in a category

Under 21 category host nation competitors allocations per category:

- 3 fighters for IFK organisation per country
- 3 fighters for non IFK organisations per country

If the IFK country does not fill its allocation, then these spaces can be filled by the non IFK organisations. A maximum of 6 fighters from a country in a category

Under 21 category bout duration:

2 minute, 2 minute, weight, 2 minutes enchosen (if 5kg weight difference the lighter competitor is declared the winner. 8kg in Men's Heavyweight)

Final 2 minute, 2 minute, 2 minute. (no weight decision).

Under 21 category compulsory safety equipment:

Shin and instep/ boy groin guard/ girl breast protector (cup type).

Under 18 category (the competitor must be 16 years or 17 years old on the first day of the competition)

Boys -60kg/ -65kg/ -70kg/ -75kg/ +75kg

Girls -50kg/ -55kg/-60kg/ +60kg

Under 18 category competitors allocations per category:

- 2 fighters for IFK organisation per country
- 2 fighters for non IFK organisations per country

If the IFK country does not fill its allocation, then these spaces can be filled by the non IFK organisations. A maximum of 4 fighters from a country in a category

Under 18 category host nation competitors allocations per category:

- 3 fighters for IFK organisation per country
- 3 fighters for non IFK organisations per country

If the IFK country does not fill its allocation, then these spaces can be filled by the non IFK organisations. A maximum of 6 fighters from a country in a category

Under 18 category bout duration:

2 minute, 2 minute, weight, 2 minutes enchosen (if 3kg weight difference the lighter competitor is declared the winner).

Final 2 minute, 2 minute, 2 minute. (no weight decision).

Under 18 category compulsory safety equipment:

Shin and instep/ boy groin guard/ girl breast protector (cup type).

Please note that Headgear is optional for Under 18 Category

Under 16 category (the competitor must be 14 years or 15 years old on the first day of the competition)

Boys -50kg/ -55kg/ -60kg/ -65kg/ +70kg

Girls -45kg/ -50kg/-55kg/ +55kg

Under 16 category competitors allocations per category:

- 2 fighters for IFK organisation per country
- 2 fighters for non IFK organisations per country

If the IFK country does not fill its allocation, then these spaces can be filled by the non IFK organisations. A maximum of 4 fighters from a country in a category

Under 16 category host nation competitors allocations per category:

- 3 fighters for IFK organisation per country
- 3 fighters for non IFK organisations per country

If the IFK country does not fill its allocation, then these spaces can be filled by the non IFK organisations. A maximum of 6 fighters from a country in a category

Under 16 category bout duration:

1.5 minute, 1.5 minute, weight, 1.5 minutes enchosen (if 3kg weight difference the lighter competitor is declared the winner).

Final 2 minute, 1.5 minute, 1.5 minute. (no weight decision).

Under 16 category compulsory safety equipment:

Shin and instep/ hand mitts/ headgear/boy groin guard/ girl breast protector (cup type).

If a category has insufficient competitors then the Pool system can be implemented.

Pool system can be either one or two rounds of the same length and all competitors within the pool will compete against each other. Competitors are given 2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw, 0 points for a loss. The winner is the competitor with the most points. If there is a tie then the lightest competitor is the winner. If the weight is the same then the youngest competitor will be declared the winner.

General Details

This championship is open for all Full Contact organisations who compete under the Knockdown rule set. Each Category has a competitor restriction for each country.

Competitors must represent their country and they must hold at least a 6th kyu (yellow belt) for adult and 21 categories, and an 8th kyu (blue belt) for categories 18 years old.

If your organisation uses a different belt structure a competitor must have a minimum of two years' experience.

ENTRANCE MUST BE COMPLETED WITH THE ONLINE FORMS BY THE COUNTRY COACH BY 1st MAY 2022

Conditions for participation:

HIV, HBV, HCV antibodies test certificate (in English) for over 18 years old must be presented at the Medical; A Doctor's "Fit to Fight" letter for all age categories must be provided at the Medical.

During the medicals there will be a verification of the competitor's age with a passport.

At this time there is not a requirement to have a 'Proof of Covid vaccination', document., however this might change subject to government rules.

Insurance:

Fighters must obtain their own insurance.

Protective Equipment:

All protection equipment/items must be individual; each fighter must have his/her own equipment.

Referee rules/uniforms:

As per IFK Kyokushin Knockdown rules/uniforms

Competition Knockdown Rules:

As per IFK Knockdown rules

Entry Procedures:

Online Fighter Entry will open in 2022, Event Website will open in November 2021

Referee Allocations:

Official quotas for Referees/Judges from a country will be set by the organiser. This is TBC

Team Coach Allocations:

The amount of Country Coaches will be set by the organiser. This is TBC

Costs:

Spectator Entrance fee is; 20 Euro for 2 days; Sayonara party fee 30 Euro. Fighters fee is 50 Euro. (Sayanora is not included).
